

2008 Showvivor Contest

Saturday, June 21, 2008

Qualified Contestant and Entry

- A qualified contestant (“Contestant”) is someone who is a BC Resident of 19 years of age or older. Employees of Great Canadian Gaming Corporation and its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, “GCGC”) and the British Columbia Lottery Corporation (“BCLC”), as well as family and household members of same who reside at the same address are not eligible.
- A qualified entry (“Entry”) is on an original GCGC entry form that must be completed by the Contestant in its entirety, must be legible and must be deposited in the draw box at one of the participating contest locations.
- Contestant and Entry must meet all Contest Conditions as outlined below. Contestant and/or Entry not meeting Contest Conditions will be disqualified and prize will be forfeited.

Contest Period

- The Contest Period runs from 10:00AM on Friday, June 20, 2008 to 1:00PM on November 2, 2008 or down to the final contestant, whichever is earliest or on such other date and time as posted by GCGC.

Contest Conditions:

- One entry per person (Entries from various email addresses will not be accepted.) Duplicate entries will cause for disqualification of all involved entries. Ballots will be made available from Hastings Live Program or from the Main Lobby Reception at Hastings Racecourse.
- Sign up begins at 10:00AM on Friday, June 20, 2008. Log on to www.hastingsracecourse.com or hand in your entry to the Main Lobby Reception at Hastings on or before 1:00PM on Saturday, June 21, 2008. Phone entry will not be accepted.
- Contestants must select one horse from a race per live card which show betting is available to finish no worse than third.
- If successful on Day no. 1, the contestant moves on to Day No. 2 and so on, the contestant(s) who have survived the longest at the end of the contest will win or share the \$3,000 in wagering voucher. The last 10 showvivors will win a Race Track Experience for Two at Hastings package.
- All entries for the remaining contest period must be submitted by email to “2008SHOWVIVOR@HASTINGSRACECOURSE.COM” or hand in to the Main Lobby Reception by 1:00PM each day of the live racing starting from June 21, 2008. Each received entry will be stamped or filed by the email time.
- If a horse you chose is scratched before the race, the horse will be replaced automatically with the post time favorite.
- If a horse is scratched from a race after 9:00AM on the day, causing a lack of a SHOW bet in the race, all selections in that race will be accepted.
- In the event the contestant selects a horse that is part of a coupled entry, you will receive both horses in the coupled entry in the Showvivor Contest. Therefore, one of the coupled horses must finish no worse than third for the contestant to remain eligible in the contest.
- In the event that the contestant did not make any selections or missed the deadline to make selections, the contestant is then disqualified from the contest. GCGC is not liable for any events which may cause the contestant to miss contest deadlines.
- Once you have submitted your entries, you can not amend or change your selection.
- Weekly updates will be posted at Guest Services.
- Winners will be contacted and have 30 days to identify themselves to Guest Services Staff in the main lobby and must provide valid photo identification before prize can be released.
- The winner must claim prize at Hastings Racecourse. Winners are responsible for collection of his/her own prize.

General Conditions

- Odds of winning depend on number of eligible entries received.
- No purchase necessary.
- Selected Contestants must have complied with all Contest Conditions and correctly answer a mathematical skill testing question to win a prize.
- All non-winning, disqualified and/or winning Entries will become the property of GCGC.
